
Representative Merrick moved to introduce legislation concerning management of interest on unclaimed funds with reference to the Kansas Public Employees System and the State General Fund (SGF). The motion was seconded by Representative Minor. Motion carried.

Representative Feuerborn moved to introduce legislation concerning surplus property, capital improvements, memorials around the State Capital and alternate fuel programs. The motion was seconded by Representative Huebert. Motion carried.

Chairman Neufeld introduced Barry Greis, Project Architect for the Statehouse Renovation Project, who presented a brief update on the renovation project. Mr. Greis stated that the project is on schedule with a projected date for completion of the parking lot of April 3, 2004. Responding to questions from the Committee, Mr. Greis indicated that the renovation is within budget at the present time. The underground water problem was anticipated and pumps have been installed to collect the water and dump into the sewer. The top of the parking garage will be waterproofed and covered with 5 to 8 feet of soil.

Mr. Greis led the Committee on a tour of the renovation of the east wing, lower level and parking garage.

Following the tour, the meeting was adjourned at 10:00 a.m. The next meeting of the Committee will be held on February 6, 2004.
