House Agriculture Committee Chairman, Dan Johnson, introduced Congressman Jerry Moran who represents the 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District of western Kansas in Washington, D.C.

Congressman Moran addressed the joint agriculture committees bringing them up to date on *What's going on in Agriculture at the Federal Level*.

The Congressman serves on the House Agriculture Committee and the General Farm Commodities and Risk Management Subcommittee. He reported that the Subcommittee is currently working on crop insurance issues, specifically, multi-year disasters. The next major issue they will be addressing is the new farm bill. The farm bill passed by Congress in 2002 will expire in 2007.

He touched on a number of issues important to agriculture, then opened the floor for questions.
