HB 2407 - Kansas representatives to regional transmission organization authorized to participate fully.

Moved by Senator Apple, seconded by Senator Lee, HB 2407 be moved out favorably. Motion carried.

HB 2263 - Kansas electric transmission authority

Moved by Senator Taddiken, seconded by Senator Francisco, amend HB 2263 by striking the word "retail" on page 6, lines 26 and 29. Motion carried.

Moved by Senator Reitz, seconded by Senator Francisco, amend HB 2263 on page 10 line 41 by changing 60 months to ten years. Motion carried. NO vote recorded by Senator Apple.

Moved by Senator Taddiken, seconded by Senator Reitz, move HB 2263 out favorably as amended. Motion carried. NO votes recorded by Senator Apple and Senator Pyle..

HB 2045 - Recovery of costs of construction and upgrading of electric transmission facilities.

Moved by Senator Reitz, seconded by Senator Pine, amend HB 2045, section 1 paragraph (a) where length of line does not need to be stipulated and move HB 2045 out favorably as amended. Motion carried.
