SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE SESSION - 2005

Chairman Umbarger called the committee's attention to the discussion of:

Senator Wysong moved, with a second by Senator Schodorf, to introduce a bill to raise \$160.041 million dollars through tax increases. The bill, as introduced, would raise the sales and compensating use tax from 5.3 percent to 5.6 percent, and would place a 2.81 percent surcharge on income taxes. The additional taxes would raise \$96.535 million through sales and compensating use taxes, and \$63.506 million through the income tax surcharge. The motion carried on a voice vote.

Senator Kelly moved, with a second by Senator Barone, to introduce a bill to repeal Section 83 of 2005 HB 2482, the proviso requiring the disclosure on media advertising from state agencies. The motion carried on a voice vote.

The meeting adjourned at 6:01 P.M. The next meeting was scheduled for June 28, 2005.
