Chairman Edmonds opened the floor for bill introductions. Hearing none, he directed the Committees' attention to **HB 2615** - colleges and universities fees and tuition; undocumented non-citizens.

Representative Kinzer made a motion that **HB 2615** be passed out of committee favorable for passage. The motion was seconded by Representative Merrick.

Representative Mah made a substitute motion to delete the word repealing in line 9 of the bill and replacing it with amending. This would state that should the provisions of it become in violation of federal law after appeals are exhausted, the provisions of this law would sunset. Representative Dillmore seconded the substitute motion

Division was requested. Motion failed.

Chairman returned to the motion by Representative Kinzer to recommend **HB 2615** favorable for passage. Vote was taken. Motion passed.
