

MINUTES OF THE SENATE EDUCATION COMMITTEE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jean Schodorf at 1:35 p.m. on February 2, 2006, in Room 123-S of the Capitol.

Dale Dennis, Deputy Commissioner, Kansas Department of Education, distributed copies of a brief review of the Title I components of No Child Left Behind and how the funds are allocated to students and school districts. (Attachment 1) In addition, he distributed a listing of federal payments distributed by the Kansas Department of Education to local school districts under the No Child Left Behind Act and the Individual with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). (Attachment 2) He reminded the Committee that the information was requested at the February 1 meeting after he presented an overview of federal funding for the No Child Left Behind Act.

Senator James Barnett requested the introduction of a school finance bill which would increase funding for K-12 by \$400 million over four years. He explained that the monies would go to at-risk and bilingual weighting increases. He noted that the current bilingual is .395, and he proposed raising that to .482. The current at-risk is .193, and he proposed raising that to .347. The remainder of the money would go to base state aid per pupil. He noted that the proposed plan would not require a tax increase. (Attachment 3)

Senator Teichman moved to introduce the proposed school finance bill, seconded by Senator Lee. The motion carried.

Senator Teichman requested the introduction of a bill concerning human sexuality education programs. She explained that the bill would take the State Board standards which expire this year and re-authorize them in statute. She noted that the purpose of the bill was to preclude the possibility of sex education not being taught in the school system.

Senator Teichman moved to introduce the proposed bill, seconded by Senator Vratil. The motion carried.

SB 332 – Authorizing Regents' institutions to acquire insurance

Deb Hollon, Kansas Legislative Research Department, explained that **SB 332** amends statutes governing state agencies' purchase of insurance. The bill would allow the state universities to purchase insurance other than employee health insurance independently of the requirements of the Committee on Surety Bond and Insurance, which oversees what insurance state agencies can buy. According to the fiscal note by the Division of Budget, there would be some savings to state universities, but an estimate of the savings could not be made because at this time it was unknown what insurance they would be buying. She explained that the bill was introduced by the LEPC at the request of the University of Kansas.

Theresa Klinkenberg, Chief Business and Financial Planning Officer for the University of Kansas, testified in support of **SB 332**. At the outset, she pointed out that the bill as currently drafted went beyond what was intended by the Board of Regents by allowing the Regents to purchase insurance independent of the Committee on Surety Bonds and Insurance without complying with certain purchasing requirements. She

explained that the intent was only to gain the flexibility to determine what risks the University could cover through the purchase of insurance. She went on to explain that the bill would improve administrative efficiencies and business practices. She explained further that the current law restricts the Board of Regents and universities from insuring property other than housing facilities, but the University of Kansas has invested heavily in equipment for the Kansas Fire and Rescue Training Institute and in research equipment such as a nuclear magnetic resonance imaging system that is critical to research. The bill would allow the Board of Regents and institutions to determine, based on risk assessment and a cost/benefit analysis, what equipment or liability to insure without seeking further legislative authorization. Ms. Klinkenberg responded to questions from the Committee. She explained that funding for the insurance would come from the University's operating grant, but she did not yet know the amount because the University has not had the ability to purchase the insurance. She noted that the University might want to consider business interruption insurance for buildings which house a large amount of research grant activities. She noted that, currently, should the fire fighting equipment be destroyed in an accident, the university would have to absorb the loss. She noted that, while there was not a statute which specifically prohibits the Regents from purchasing insurance, past attempts to purchase insurance were denied by the Department of Administration because there was no specific authorization. At this point, Angela Hoobler, Department of Administration, Division of Purchases, stated, "I believe that there is a statute that states that no agency may buy insurance unless there is specific authorization. I can't quote it for you, but I believe that there is one, and that's what we've operated under."

Written testimony in support of **SB 332** was submitted by Reginald L. Robinson, President and CEO, Kansas Board of Regents. Mr. Robinson noted that it was important to point out that the bill as currently drafted went beyond the Board's original intent and that an amendment was drafted to correct the error. (Attachment 5)

Larry Magill, Kansas Association of Insurance Agents (KAIA), explained that he had intended to testify in opposition to **SB 332**; however, he felt the proposed amendment addressed his objections, and he was comfortable with the bill with the amendment. He noted that KAIA has found that the Surety Bonds and Insurance Committee bidding process has worked well for years and was concerned about carving all the university insurance purchases out of the normal sealed competitive bidding process. He noted that one aspect the bill originally would have done was allow the purchase of insurance from carriers that are not licensed to do business in Kansas. (Attachment 6)

Theresa Kiernan, Revisor of Statutes Office, explained that the language in the balloon amendment (Attachment 7) did not accomplish what was intended, and in essence, the language returned to current law. Keith Yehle, University of Kansas, stood to inform the Committee that the Assistant General Council for the Board of Regents had reviewed and approved the amendment. Senator Schodorf suggested that Ms. Kiernan work with the Regents staff to draft statutory language which would clearly reflect the Regents' intent in the bill. With this, the hearing on **SB 332** was closed.

Senator Schodorf informed the Committee that Val Defever, Schools for Quality Education, had requested that Pattie Wolters, USD 105 Board of Education President from Atwood, be allowed to speak before the Senate Education Committee on the importance of low enrollment weighting funds for small school districts which have consolidated, not by choice but by necessity due to population density. Ms. Wolters outlined the USD 105 cost cutting measures, the LOB and consolidation budget, the opportunity gap that exists for many students in small rural schools, teacher salary costs, increasing costs for the district, the economic development aspect of small schools, and the need for the flexibility to use funds to serve students and to maintain regular education teaching positions. Senator Schodorf called the Committee's attention to the minutes of the January 11 and 12 meetings. Senator Teichman moved to approve the minutes of the January 11-12, 2006, meetings, seconded by Senator Ostmeyer. The motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:25 p.m.

The next meeting is scheduled for February 6, 2006.

SUBJECT: Federal Funding

Please find attached a listing of federal aid payments distributed by the Kansas State Department of Education to local school districts under the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act and the Individual With Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) for the 2004-05 school year. The total amount distributed to school districts under NCLB was \$141,908,554.28 and the total amount distributed under IDEA was \$69,790,128, for a grand total of \$211,698,682.28.

Also shown below is a summary of the allocation of federal funds awarded to the Kansas State Department of Education under the No Child Left Behind Act for the 2004-05 school year.

Almost half the funding for state-level activities is generated by the Reading First Program to provide professional development and technical assistance to reading teachers. Another large share is allocated from the Improving Teacher Quality Program to provide professional development to teachers and principals and increase the number of highly qualified teachers in Kansas schools.

It is important to note that not all the funds under NCLB are distributed by the State Department of Education. The federal government distributes some federal funds directly to school districts as follows.

Chairwoman Schodorf and members of the Committee, I am Theresa Klinkenberg, Chief Fiscal Officer for the University of Kansas. I appreciate the opportunity to speak today in favor of Senate Bill 332 which provides Regents institutions the flexibility to determine what kind of insurance is necessary and procure that insurance without specific statutory authorization. I will note that the bill as currently drafted goes beyond what was intended by the Board of Regents by allowing the Regents to purchase insurance independent of the committee on surety bonds and insurance and without complying with certain purchasing requirements. We intended only to gain the flexibility to determine what risks the University could cover through the purchase of insurance. We have prepared a balloon amendment for the Committee's consideration that corrects the error.

As many members of this committee know, in 2002 the business officers from the Regents universities made a comprehensive study to identify areas where modifications of state laws, policies or procedures would result in administrative efficiencies and cost savings. The recommendations produced by this study were presented to the Governor and the Department of Administration, and Legislature.

I want to thank this committee in particular for the strong support you provided to enact a number of bills and support other changes in policies and business practices at that time.

Examples of changes enacted based on the 2002 study included:

- full pre-audit authority was delegated to the universities,
- surplus property procedures were modified to allow for local disposition of surplus property,
- local option printing was authorized, and
- the fee structure in the Division of Facilities Management was revised.

We believe each of these changes have been successful and have allowed for more efficient operations at the campuses and in central offices.

In the spirit of continuing the process started in 2002, this year the Universities and Regents have made several additional proposals to improve administrative efficiencies and business practices. SB 332 is one of those initiatives, and is proposed to you today for that purpose.

The Universities have grown over time and have acquired significant assets that are critical to their educational and research missions. Under current law, a university must have specific authority to insure those assets. Housing facilities can be insured under specific statutory authorization, some buildings and contents can be insured if there are revenue bonds outstanding or if required by a Federal grant. The current law restricts the Board of Regents and Universities from insuring other property – property that may be critical to a university’s mission that could not be replaced if lost or damaged.

For the Committee's consideration, I would like to provide a couple of examples. The Kansas Fire & Rescue Training Institute that is operated through the Division of Continuing Education at the University of Kansas is required to maintain a fleet of equipment in order to fulfill the mission assigned by KSA 76-327 that requires a "traveling instructional service" for the fire departments in Kansas. The equipment owned by the Institute has a replacement value of over \$1 million – a Live Fire Training Simulator, a Search and Rescue Trainer, a Propane Gas Fire Fighting Trainer and others. If any single unit were lost through an accident, replacement from existing funding levels would be extremely difficult if not impossible.

The University has invested heavily in research equipment in recent years – an 800 megahertz Nuclear Magnetic Resonance Imaging system, a proteomics analyzer and other equipment that is critical to cancer and biosciences research. Some of this equipment is insured because the bonds that financed their purchase are still outstanding. When those bonds mature in a few years, however, the University will not have the authority to insure the equipment and will risk losing several millions of dollars in research grants if the equipment is damaged and cannot be replaced.

SB 332 allows the Board of Regents and institutions to determine based on risk assessment and a cost/benefit analysis, what equipment or liability to insure without seeking further legislative authorization.

We intended that all purchases would be made through the committee on surety bonds and insurance, following existing state laws, and utilizing best business practices.

On behalf of the Board of Regents, I write to express the Board's support for Senate Bill 332. This legislation would allow the state universities, on a campus-by-campus basis, to determine their insurance needs and to purchase insurance products, except employee health insurance, at the campus level.

Senate Bill 332 is the result of a proposal that the University of Kansas (KU) brought before the Board of Regents for consideration this past fall. The Board endorsed KU's proposal in November 2005, and it was subsequently introduced for legislative consideration by the Legislative Educational Planning Committee.

In 2002, the State University Council of Business Officers conducted a comprehensive study to identify areas for relief from state administrative procedures that could result in administrative efficiencies. As a result of this study, and with the cooperation of the Department of Administration, a number of statutes and business practices were changed. In the spirit of continuing this valuable effort to identify and implement best business practices, Senate Bill 332 has been introduced for your consideration.

It is important to point out that Senate Bill 332, as currently drafted, goes beyond what the Board originally intended – it would permit the purchase of insurance independent of the Committee on Surety Bonds and Insurance and without complying with certain purchasing requirements. KU has drafted an amendment that corrects this error.

Testimony on Senate Bill 332
Before the Senate Education Committee
By Larry Magill
February 2, 2006

Thank you madam Chairwoman and members of the committee for the opportunity to appear today in opposition to SB 332. My name is Larry Magill and I represent the Kansas Association of Insurance Agents. We have approximately 425 member agencies across the state and another 125 branch offices that employ a total of approximately 2,500 people. Our members write roughly 70% of the business property and liability insurance in Kansas and 35% of the personal insurance. Independent agents are free to represent a number of different insurance companies.

Significant Policy Issues in the Bill

We are concerned that there are significant policy issues in the bill and a radical departure from the way the state handles its purchasing of insurance and feel that it needs more study. For example, the bill exempts all insurance purchases by postsecondary educational institutions from the Surety Bonds & Insurance Committee, the arm of state government that handles virtually all state purchases of insurance and takes it out of the normal sealed competitive bidding process.

Generally the state determines what types and amounts of insurance state agencies may purchase and those purchases must be made through the Surety Bonds & Insurance Committee. This will allow the Regents Institutions to purchase any type of insurance and through any type of process, negotiated, private bid, public bid or some combination, that they choose.

The Surety Bonds and Insurance Committee has always taken the position that the insurance must be from an admitted carrier. This proposal, by removing the Surety Bonds & Insurance Committee from the process also likely eliminates their requirement that the insurer be admitted. That means that they are free to use non-admitted carriers, carriers who have refused to be subject to the regulatory control of the Kansas Insurance Department, are not covered by any guaranty fund if they fail and whose rates and policy forms are not filed and approved by the Department. Nor can the Department exert any leverage on the carrier in a claim dispute since our unfair trade practices act does not apply.

Can Negotiate Now

The states insurance purchasing process has been in place for many years and has worked well. In 2004 we worked with the proponents of SB 392 that was eventually rolled into HB 2597 that gave the Surety Bonds and Insurance Committee a process they can go through to negotiate for insurance where that works better in the marketplace. There are times and for certain coverage where negotiation may work better in terms of cost or coverage than a strict sealed bid process. But that authority already exists.

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We would hate to see a system where insurance were used as a form of political patronage. I'm sure that isn't the intent here but you can't be certain that someone in the future would not abuse the authority. We think this needs further study and urge the Committee not to act on it.

Rawlins County USD 105

Rawlins County USD 105 is the new district formed from the Atwood and Herndon Consolidation in 2003. Small School districts are located through out the state of Kansas. It is important to note why a district is small. Population density dictates that our school is small. USD 105 is 740 square miles, or about 30 miles by 25 miles. We are located in the center of Rawlins Co. with schools 30 miles to the east, south, and west and Nebraska bordering on the north. In the last ten years, we have lost 245 students and now have 354 students in our district. We are not small by choice, we are small by necessity.

Cost cutting measures

Moved district office to elementary school and sold district office building.

Closed one school building (former Herndon School).

Cut administration in half. Our district now has a 7-12 Principal and a Superintendent/Elementary Principal.

16 fewer teaching positions in the last 5 years.

LOB and Consolidation Budget

The Atwood District prior to consolidation was at the maximum 25% LOB. USD 105 has the combined Atwood and Herndon Budgets for a period of four years. With these additional funds, we have been able to maintain 6 teaching positions that would otherwise have been cut, in addition to doing some capital improvements and technology upgrades. The LOB is at 19% this year. USD 105 will certainly be at 27% when we revert to the regular budget in the 2007-2008 school year, just to cover basic operating expenses.

Opportunity gap

It is recognized that there is an achievement gap for some students in Kansas, but we must also recognize that there is an opportunity gap that exists for many students in small rural schools. Our consolidation was driven by the need to provide opportunity for students. With cuts that have already been made to low enrollment weighting and further cuts recommended by the Post Audit report, USD 105 is now looking at losing our ability to provide those opportunities to our students. We would lose the 6 teaching positions mentioned above, as well as 2 or 3 more. Operating within the dollars of our regular state school budget we would probably first cut parts of positions equal to two teacher positions. Then each regular education position we cut would be cutting a department: Vocational Education, Industrial Arts, Technology/Business, Art, or Physical Education. At risk is also our AP Calc and AP English classes with only 3 -5 students in each class. Can a small school offer what a large district can? Obviously, no we can't, but we should be able to offer our students a selection of classes and excellence in the basics.

Teacher Salary Costs

The Post Audit Study shows that small districts pay lower salaries than larger districts and therefore need less money to pay those salaries. I look at it differently. Small school Boards of Education have been more conservative when giving teacher salary raises. By giving smaller raises, we have been able to stretch our salary dollars and have one or maybe two more teachers.

Increasing cost we have to cover

Utilities and the fuel used in transportation are increasing. Transportation for a large-area, low density district is high. Living in the far Northwestern corner of Kansas means we travel a long way to many student school events and for meetings for teachers, administrators, and boards.

Economic Development aspect of Small Schools

The sale of the Herndon School Building to Cencast, an Oregon company whose mission is to be the recognized leader in the field of small detailed precision castings, was finalized in January. The company will be expanding their operation to the former Herndon School Building. They plan to have 10 jobs at the former school by the end of the year, with plans to add 5 additional jobs each year for the next 3 years. When they visited Rawlins County they inspected the schools from top to bottom. They were impressed with the achievement scores and our schools.

The Need for Low Enrollment Weighting Funds

Post Audit shows USD 105 total funding would be lower. It also moves much of the Low Enrollment Weighting Funds to At Risk Funding. Our Achievement Gap is smaller and our need for At Risk Funds probably won't be as great. We will not be able to use At Risk Funds to pay for Regular Education Teachers. Loosing our flexibility to use funds where they will best serve our student population could limit the opportunities our students have. We need Low Enrollment Weighting funds to maintain regular education teaching positions.

We can't eliminate another building or another administrator. We have consolidated and are 30 miles from each of the schools bordering us. Low Enrollment Weighting is what gives us the ability to maintain the opportunities we offer our students.
