HB 2329 - Change the name of the "capitol area security patrol" to "capitol police."

HB 2532 - Professional corporations, occupational therapists and physical therapists

HB 2966 - Ordering out militia in local, state or federal disaster.

HB 2982 - Kansas intrastate emergency mutual aid act

The Chairman explained the bills to the committee.
