Chair Landwehr announced that the committee would work HB2214 - Regulation of sedation permits by Kansas dental board.

Revisor Norman Furse updated the committee on amendments made per the hearings on February 19. Representative Flaharty asked whether the contents of HB2215 - Kansas dental board, fee for permits have been included in the changes. Mr. Furse replied that they have. Representative Morrison motioned to adopt amendments as presented which was seconded by Representative Mast. Motion carried. Representative Morrison motioned that the bill be passed favorably as amended, which was seconded by Representative Neighbors. Motion carried.

Chair Landwehr said that we would now work HB2255 - Human cloning, prohibiting certain expenditures of moneys appropriated from the state treasury by state agencies. Representative Mast made a motion, seconded by Representative Morrison, to changed the definitions in HB 2255 to match the definitions in HB 2098 which was passed out by this committee on February 13. Motion carried. Representative Mast made a motion to pass this bill favorably as amended. Motion seconded by Representative Morrison. Motion carried.

Chair Landwehr opened the floor to work HB 2418 - General hospital defined. Representative Neighbor motioned to pass this bill favorably, which was seconded by Representative Hill.

Representative Mast made a substitute motion to delete lines 25-35 from the bill. Following discussion, Representative Mast withdrew her motion.

Vote was taken on the motion by Representative Neighbor to pass this bill favorably. Motion carried.

Chair Landwehr announced that we would now work HB 2483 - Physical therapists evaluation and treatment of patients. Representative Crum made a motion for a technical change in bill wording, which was seconded by Representative Colyer. Motion carried.

Revisor Norman Furse suggested another technical amendment. Representative Storm motioned that the committee accept the amendment as proposed by Mr. Furse. Motion was seconded by Representative Neighbor. Motion carried.

Representative Neighbor motioned that HB 2483 be passed favorably as amended. Second by Representative Hill. Motion Carried.

Representative Landwehr thanked the committee for their efforts during the first portion of this session and adjourned the meeting. Next meeting will be announced by the Chair.
