Chairman Brungardt opened the confirmation hearing on:

Colonel Deborah Rose, Chief of Staff, Kansas Air National Guard

An introduction for the confirmation candidate was provided by Major General Tod Bunting, Adjutant General Kansas Air National Guard. Colonel Deborah Rose, appeared before the committee to answer questions on her appointment to Chief of Staff, Kansas Air National Guard. (Attachment 1) The committee requested information from the appointment questionnaire form on the experience and affiliations page, and what her duties would be. The Colonel will be the Director of the Joint Force Headquarters and duties will include organizing, training, and deploying the National Guard forces into the community in the event of an emergency.

Senator Brownlee made a motion to move to the full Senate the confirmation of Colonel Deborah Rose. Senator Vratil seconded the motion. The motion carried.

SB 368 - Professional corporations, allowing licensed audiologists to form

Chairman Brungardt opened the hearing on **SB 368**.

John Peterson, Kansas Speech and Hearing Association, appeared before the committee in favor of the bill with amendments. (Attachment 2) The bill would allow a licensed audiologist to organize as a professional corporation under the Kansas Professional Corporation Code, and the proposed amendment would propose the same flexibility be made available to licensed speech-language pathologists.

Jeffrey Brown, Triplett, Woolf & Garretson, LLC, provided written testimony in support of the bill and amendment. (Attachment 3)

Chairman Brungardt closed the hearing on **SB 368**.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:58 am. The next scheduled meeting is March 14, 2007.




I was the first female in the Kansas Air National Guard to be selected as a Group Commander and again as Vice Commander. I have also been the Project Manager for the most significant domestic response addition to the Kansas National Guard, the Expeditionary Medical Support System (EMEDS)

My daughter, Jessica P. Frye, is employed by The Adjutant General's department.

Other litigation:

A former employee of the YWCA has threatened a lawsuit over her dismissal.



Mr. Chairman, Senators. My name is John Peterson. I am pleased to appear today in support of Senate Bill 368 on behalf of Kansas Speech-Language-Hearing Association. The Kansas-Speech-Language-Hearing Association is a professional trade association for licensed speech pathologists and licensed audiologists in the State of Kansas, over 1,000 of which are members of this Association.

We appear today in support of Senate Bill 368 which would allow a licensed audiologist to organize as a professional corporation under the Kansas Professional Corporation Code. We believe that this alternative would allow greater flexibility for a licensed audiologist who is in private practice and desires to organize in a corporate structure.

We would propose that the same flexibility be made available to licensed speech-language pathologists and are proposing an amendment that would allow for such an option. We further believe that it is desirable to amend K.S.A. 17-2710, the statute that allows two or more professions to join together as a professional corporation, be amended to reflect conformity to this proposed change. Those amendments are on the attached balloon.

We would urge your favorable consideration of the proposed amendments and Senate Bill 368. Thank you.

(b) to purchase, receive, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares of other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, associations, partnerships or individuals, insurance or annuities in any form, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or of any other government, state, territory, governmental district or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof;

(c) to pay pensions and establish pension plans, profit-sharing plans, stock bonus plans, stock option plans and other incentive plans for any or all of its directors, officers and employees;

(d) to do all things necessary or incidental to the practice of the profession which the professional corporation is authorized to practice.
