Chairman Owens informed the committee that **SB 582** had been referred from the Judiciary Committee to the Select Committee on Corrections Reform and Oversight. The bill has to do with driving under the influence, ignition interlock and impoundment of vehicle. Discussion focused on lines 20-26 on page 7 which deals with granting retroactive jurisdiction to municipal courts over DUI violations which the district courts also have jurisdiction over, as long as the elements of the ordinance violation are the same as the statute on DUI and the violation would constitute a felony.

Representative Johnson moved that the amendments contained in lines 20-26 on page 7 of SB 582 be amended into a gutted SB 214. Representative Holmes seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Representative Johnson moved that SB 214 be passed out favorably as House Substitute for SB 214. Representative Colloton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
