Higher Education "Block Grant" Funding Overview

Diane C. Duffy, Vice-President, Finance and Administration

Chairman Huntington, and members of the Committee, thank you for the opportunity to appear before you this afternoon to provide an overview of the "block grant" budgeting model.

First, each state university has a section in the annual appropriation bills and each state university has a SGF line item appropriation within their section that appropriated base operating expenditures and other direct SGF appropriations unique to an individual university, such as the special appropriation for the Kansas Wetlands Education Center at Cheyenne Bottoms or the Cancer Center at the University of Kansas Medical Center. The Board office section of the appropriation bill includes the individual SGF line-items for the base operating grants for the community colleges and Washburn universities and postsecondary aid to technical colleges/community colleges that are statutorily eligible for postsecondary aid. (See the attached 2008 SB 534 – mega appropriation bill).

In 2000, the Board, Governor, and Legislature moved to this new budget model for the state universities called the state operating grant/tuition ownership model, under which each university would receive a state operating grant and would retain ownership of and accountability for its tuition revenue. Each university would receive a state operating grant based on a request determined by the Board. Upon the Board's approval of tuition rates, each university would assess, collect and have expenditure authority over all of its tuition revenue.

Under the state operating grant/tuition ownership budget model, any increase in state appropriations over the previous year are appropriated to the State Board of Regents in what has been called a "block grant." For several years, the Legislature appropriated new funding in a line-item called state university operating grant. Last year all new funding for state universities, community colleges, technical colleges and Washburn University was appropriated in a single line item called postsecondary education operating grant account.

In a year of budget reductions such as this year, where there are no new operating grant dollars for institutions, the Governor and Legislature make reductions to each of the individual operating expenditures accounts of the state universities as well as the individual line items within the Board office for the community college operating grant, Washburn University operating grant account and postsecondary aid for technical institutions.

House Higher Education Committee February 26, 2009 Attachment 1 The Legislature has granted authority in the appropriation bill to the President and CEO of the Board to transfer funds between SGF line-items with the approval of the state budget director.

In a year of budget increases, the new SGF funding has been distributed by the Board to the universities using an established distribution methodology. Because the universities vary greatly in their ability to generate tuition revenue, the current formula, in place for several years was designed to help account for the difference in the capacity to generate tuition revenues. This methodology distributes an additional one percent to the University of Kansas Medical Center, Kansas State University – Extension Systems and Agriculture Research Programs (which generates no tuition revenue), and each of the regional universities (Emporia State University, Pittsburg State University, Fort Hays State University). An additional half percent is distributed to Wichita State University. Once the Board approves the amounts to be distributed from the new SGF funds, a transfer is made from the block grant to the operating expenditure account of each state university and becomes a part of the universities' base appropriation.

The community colleges have a distribution formula that is contained in state statute and Board staff works closely with the community colleges to run the distribution calculation that determines the amount to each individual college.

With regard to the technical colleges and several of the community colleges eligible to access postsecondary aid, there is a distribution formula in place that uses a three-year rolling average of enrollments to determine the amount to each.

The Board makes allocations to the sectors and distributions to individual institutions within a sector in June of each year to start the new fiscal year on July 1.

Finally, it is important to note, that any increase in funding for all institutions is contingent upon the Board's assessment of each university's performance pursuant to the performance agreement process. (d) (1) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made by any state educational institution from the moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special revenue fund for fiscal year 2009 for such state educational institution as authorized by this or other appropriation act of the 2008 regular session of the legislature, expenditures may be made by such state educational institution from moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special

revenue fund for fiscal year 2009 for the purposes of capital improvement projects making energy and other conservation improvements: Provided, That such capital improvement projects are hereby approved for such state educational institution for the purposes of subsection (b) of K.S.A. 74-8905, and amendments thereto, and the authorization of issuance of one or more series of bonds by the Kansas development finance authority in accordance with that statute from time to time during fiscal year 2009: Provided, however, That no such bonds shall be issued until the state board of regents has first advised and consulted on any such project with the joint committee on state building construction: Provided, further, That the amount of the bond proceeds that may be utilized for any such capital improvement project shall be subject to approval by the state fi-nance council acting on this matter which is hereby characterized as a matter of legislative delegation and subject to the guidelines prescribed in subsection (c) of K.S.A. 75-3711c, and amendments thereto, except that such approval also may be given while the legislature is in session: And provided further, That, in addition to such project costs, any such amount of bond proceeds may include costs of issuance, capitalized interest and any required reserves for the payment of principal and interest on such bonds: And provided further, That all moneys received from the issuance of any such bonds shall be deposited and accounted for as prescribed by applicable bond covenants: And provided further, That payments relating to principal and interest on such bonds shall be subject to and dependent upon annual appropriations therefor to the state educational institution for which the bonds are issued: And provided further, That each energy conservation capital improvement project for which bonds are issued for financing under this subsection shall be designed and completed in order to have cost savings sufficient to be equal or greater than the cost of debt service on such bonds: And provided further, That the state board of regents shall prepare and submit a report to the committee on appropriations of the house of representatives and the committee on ways and means of the senate on the savings attributable to energy conservation capital improvements for which bonds are issued for financing under this subsection at the beginning of the 2009 regular session of the legislature.

(2) As used in this subsection, "state educational institution" includes each state educational institution as defined in K.S.A. 76-711, and amend-

nents thereto.

(e) In addition to other expenditures authorized to be made from the comprehensive grant program account of the state general fund for fiscal year 2009 for the awards of Kansas comprehensive grants in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 74-32,120 through 74-32,125, and amendments thereto, and policies and rules and regulations adopted by the state board of regents for the administration of the Kansas comprehensive grant program, expenditures shall be made from the comprehensive grant program account of the state general fund for fiscal year 2009 for awards of Kansas comprehensive grants to eligible Kansas students who are enrolling or enrolled at an institution of higher education which is accredited by the Association for Biblical Higher Education and which has its main campus or principal place of operation located in Kansas, and otherwise in accordance with and subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 74-32,120 through 74-32,125, and amendments thereto, and policies and rules and regulations adopted by the state board of regents for the administration of the Kansas comprehensive grant program.

(f) (1) The state board of regents is authorized to expend moneys appropriated by this section in the military service scholarships account of the state general fund for the payment of tuition and fees for persons described in paragraph (2) at Kansas educational institutions as defined by K.S.A. 75-4364, and amendments thereto: *Provided*, That the state board of regents is authorized to determine the terms and conditions

relating to such educational assistance.

(2) The educational assistance provided by this subsection shall be for any person: (A) who graduated from high school in Kansas or who, as a resident of Kansas for at least two years, has received a general educational development (G.E.D.) credential; and (B) who either (i) has served in military service in Iraq or Afghanistan at least 90 days after September 11, 2001, or served less than such 90 days because of injuries received in Iraq or Afghanistan or (ii) has served in military service in international

waters or on foreign soil in support of military operations in Iraq or Afghanistan for at least 90 days after September 11, 2001, or has service less than 90 days because of injuries received during such service; and (C) the person has received an honorable discharge from military service active duty orders that indicate the person has served after September 11, 2001, in one or more of the following military operations: (i) Enduring Freedom; (ii) Nobel Eagle; or (iii) Iraqi Freedom.

(g) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state economic development initiatives fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the

following:

SEDIF — vocational education capital outlay aid..... Provided, That expenditures from the vocational education capital outlay aid account for each grant of vocational education capital outlay aid shall be matched by the area vocational school, the area vocational-technical school or the technical college awarded such grant in an amount which is equal to 50% of the grant: *Provided further*, That any unencumbered balance in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2008, in the vocational education capital outlay aid account is hereby reappropriated for fiscal year 2009.

SEDIF - technology innovation and internship program..... \$180,500 Provided, That any unencumbered balance in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2008, in the technical innovation and internship program account is

hereby reappropriated for fiscal year 2009.

(h) On July 1, 2008, the ROTC scholarship reimbursement account of the state general fund of the state board of regents is hereby redesignated as the ROTC service scholarships account of the state general fund of the state board of regents.

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

(a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the following: Operating expenditures Provided, That any unencumbered balance in the central administration operations and parole and postrelease supervision operations account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2008, is hereby reappropriated to the operating expenditures account for fiscal year 2009: Provided, however, That

expenditures from the operating expenditures account for official hospitality shall not exceed \$2,000.

Community corrections \$19,548,912 Provided, That any unencumbered balance in the community corrections account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2008, is hereby reappropriated for fiscal year 2009. Provided, however, That no expenditures may be made by any county from any grant made to such county from the community corrections account for either half of state fiscal year 2009 which supplant any amount of local public or private funding of existing programs as determined in accordance with rules and regulations adopted by the secretary of corrections.

Day reporting centers and reentry programs Provided, That any unencumbered balance in the day reporting centers and reentry programs account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2008, is hereby reappropriated for fiscal year 2009: Provided further, That all expenditures from the day reporting centers and reentry programs account shall be made pursuant to contracts which are hereby authorized to be entered into by the secretary of corrections with the counties of Sedgwick, Shawnee and Wyandotte and the cities of Topeka, Kansas City

and Wichita, Kansas, for operation of such reentry programs.

Local jail payments..... Provided, That, notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 19-1930, and amendments thereto, payments by the department of corrections under subsection (b) of K.S.A. 19-1930, and amendments thereto, for the cost of maintenance of prisoners shall not exceed the per capita daily operating cost, not including inmate programs, for the department of corrections.
