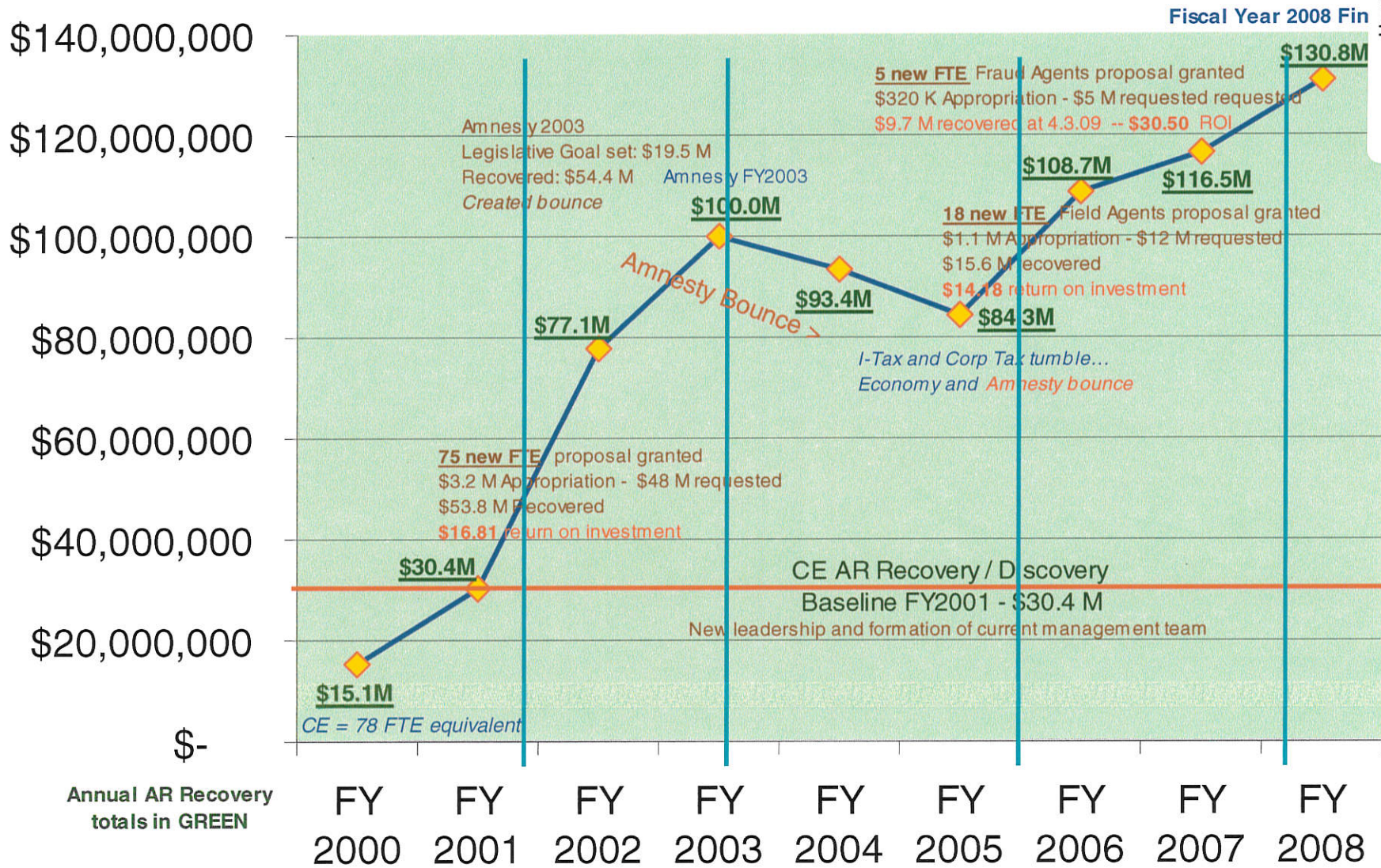
AR Recovery & Discovery FY2000 to FY2008
