Senator McGinn asked Committee members to reconsider the action taken on **HB 2283 - Procedures for release of certain property of rural water districts**. She proposed an amendment to insert language contained in **HB 2272 - Procedures for designation of an intensive groundwater use control area**, as amended by the House Committee of the Whole, into the language of **HB 2283**.

Senator Taddiken moved to reconsider the action taken on HB 2283. Senator Teichman seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Abrams moved to amend HB 2283, by inserting the proposed language contained in HB 2272. Senator Teichman seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Abrams moved to amend new section 1 and replace "not less than 30 days" with "not less than 60 days." Senator Bruce seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Teichman moved to pass HB 2283 favorably as amended out of Committee. Senator Abrams seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
