Chairman Hayzlett called the meeting to order. He discussed with the Committee the need for a bill regarding a new comprehensive transportation program. The Chairman asked staff to brief the Committee on proposed language to have placed in the transportation bill. The language would include sections in **HB 2617 and HB 2618**. It does not include sections from those bills that would increase revenues.

After discussions and all questions had been answered Chairman Hayzlett opened **SB 302** to the Committee for the purposes of preparing a transportation plan. **Representative Worley made a motion to amend SB 302 with the proposed language and to designate it as H Sub for SB 302. The motion was seconded by Representative Swanson and the motion carried. Representative Kleeb made a motion to favorably pass H Sub for SB 302, seconded by Representative Wetta and the motion carried.**

There being no further business before the Committee, the Chairman adjourned the meeting and expressed thanks and appreciation to all members for a job well done.
