MINUTES OF THE SENATE AGRICULTURE COMMITTEE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Taddiken at 8:40 a.m. on March 16, 2010, in Room 144-S of the Capitol.

The Committee held hearings on <u>HB 2566 - Food and drug inspection duties under the department of agriculture</u> on March 3. Discussion was held on the possibility of amending <u>HB 2566</u> by placing the House version of <u>SB 395 - Changes to dairy, milk and milk product statutes</u> into <u>HB 2566</u>.

Kristen Kellems, Office of the Revisor of Statutes, presented an explanation of changes made by the House to <u>SB 395</u> and the changes which would occur by placing the House version of <u>SB 395</u> into <u>HB 2566.</u> The Revisor would also make necessary technical changes to the bill.

Constantine Cotsoradis, Deputy Secretary, Kansas Department of Agriculture (KDA) answered questions from the Committee.

Senator Bruce made a motion to amend **HB 2566** by placing the contents of **SB 395** (as amended by the House) into **HB 2566** and allow technical changes by the Revisor's office. Senator Ostmeyer seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Senator Ostmeyer moved that **HB 2566** be reported out favorably as amended. Seconded by Senator Bruce. Motion carried.

HB 2508 - Shortening the length of deferral time for certain inmates' parole hearings to five years and requiring review of inmates on a 10 year deferral was referred to the Agriculture Committee yesterday. Chairman Taddiken noted that the original SB 425 dealt with blending motor-vehicle fuel at the terminal. The House changed the entire contents of the bill and is now House Sub for S 425 by Committee on Commerce and Labor - Employment security law; contribution rates option; no penalties or interest up to 90 days late.

Senator Morris moved the removal of the contents of **HB 2508** and placing the contents of **SB 425** as it left the Senate into **HB 2508**. Senator Francisco seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Senator Bruce moved that HB 2508, as amended, be passed favorably out of Committee. Motion carried.

Senator Bruce moved the approval of the March 3 meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Senator Lee. Motion carried.

Chairman Taddiken said that concludes the work of the Agriculture Committee for the 2010 session.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 a.m.
