

CHAPTER 103

Substitute for HOUSE BILL No. 2108
(Amended by Chapter 146)

AN ACT relating to insurance; concerning unfair trade practices; amending
K.S.A. 40-2416 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. (a) The commissioner of insurance shall have the authority to adopt such rules and regulations to protect service members of the United States armed forces from dishonest and predatory insurance sales practices by declaring certain identified practices to be false, misleading, deceptive or unfair except, that such rules and regulations shall not affect federal insurance programs under subchapter III of chapter 19 of title 38, United States Code.

(b) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the unfair trade practice law.

New Sec. 2. K.S.A. 40-2401 through 40-2414, sections 1 and 2, and amendments thereto, may be cited as the unfair trade practice law.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 40-2416 is hereby amended to read as follows: 40-2416. When used in this act: "Commissioner" shall mean the commissioner of insurance of this state; "unfair trade practice law" shall mean K.S.A. 40-2401 through 40-2414, *sections 1 and 2*, and ~~acts amendatory thereof and supplemental amendments~~ *thereof and supplemental amendments* thereto; "residents" shall mean and include person, partnership or corporation, domestic, alien or foreign.

Sec. 4. K.S.A. 40-2416 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
