SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 463

As Amended by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

SB 463 would amend the Liquor Control Act to: (1) delete the requirement that the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) issue permits for common carriers to transport liquor in Kansas; and (2) delete the requirement that common carriers must submit duplicate bills of lading to the Director of ABC.

The Senate Committee amended the bill to delete obsolete language regarding "bonded" warehouses.

Background

The Director of ABC requested SB 463 to modernize procedures under the Liquor Control Act. The Director stated that common carriers already are registered through the Kansas Corporation Commission. The duplicate bills of lading have not been required for many years.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget states that passage of the bill would result in negligible operational savings.
