**CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT BRIEF
HOUSE BILL NO. 2297**

As Agreed to April 4, 2003

Brief *

HB 2297 provides that an order of garnishment will attach to property other than earnings if an order to pay the court is served within 60 days of the receipt of the answer of the garnishee. If after 60 days following the receipt no order to pay has been received, the garnishee must release the funds, credits, or indebtedness that has been withheld.

Background

The Senate Committee amendment was clarifying in nature to reword the current law and the proposed amendment. It also changed the "shall" to "may" in regard to the garnishee releasing funds after 60 days when no order to pay has been received.

The Conference Committee agreed to the Senate amendments and made further clarifications.
