**CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT BRIEF  
HOUSE BILL NO. 2262**

As Agreed to March 29, 2005

**Brief \***

HB 2262 would amend a provision of the Civil Procedure Code regarding legal holidays which now include those designated by Congress or the Legislature also to include any day observed as a holiday by order of the Supreme Court.

**Conference Committee Action**

The Conference Committee agreed to delete the Senate Committee amendment language "or the Governor."

**Background**

The bill was supported by an individual who is also a Deputy Appellate Defender and thus involved in computing legal deadlines. Court holidays do not always match those designated by Congress or the Legislature, which can cause confusion when dealing with filing deadlines under the Code of Civil Procedure.

The fiscal note indicated no fiscal effect.
