SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 9

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Education

Brief*

SB 9 would repeal language in KSA 71-202 concerning contracts between community colleges and out-of-state educational institutions. Currently, KSA 71-202:

- Prohibits contracts between community colleges and institutions outside of the states surrounding Kansas;
- Prohibits any contract other than those for healing arts, medical skills or techniques, or medical sciences;
- Requires approval of any contract by the Board of Regents and authorizes legislative changes to those contracts; and
- Requires the community colleges to provide statistical and financial reports to the Board of Regents.

SB 9 would repeal these provisions.

Background

SB 9 was introduced by the Legislative Educational Planning Committee as a part of the legislative package requested by the Board of Regents. Representatives from the Board of Regents testified to the Senate Committee in favor of the bill. There were no conferees in opposition to the bill.
