SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2027

<u>As Recommended by House Committee on</u>
<u>Governmental Organization and Elections</u>

Brief*

HB 2027 would reduce to one year the period a two-term municipal library board member must wait before being reappointed. Current law prohibits anyone who has been appointed for two consecutive four-year terms from being reappointed until two years after the expiration of the second term.

Background

Representative Kenny Wilk testified as a proponent of the bill, and others provided written testimony. Proponents said it is becoming increasingly difficult to find individuals willing to serve on local library boards.

The bill applies to city, county and township libraries created under K.S.A. 12-1218 *et. seq.*

The bill would have no fiscal effect, according to the fiscal note.
