SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2090

As Recommended by House Committee on Transportation

Brief*

H B 2090 provides that a law enforcement officer shall issue a citation to the owner of a motor vehicle, if the owner or any other person operating the vehicle fails to display evidence of financial security upon demand by the officer. The law enforcement officer would mail the citation to the owner unless the owner was issued the citation at the time the demand for evidence of financial security was made by the officer.

Background

Representative Bob Bethell testified in support of the bill before the House Transportation Committee. He explained that the bill would place the responsibility of having insurance clearly on the owner of the vehicle rather than on the driver.

No other conferees testified before the House Transportation Committee

The fiscal note from the Division of Budget indicates that the Office of Judicial Administration and the Kansas Association of Counties report that the bill would not have a fiscal effect on their budgets.
