SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2157

As Amended by House Committee on Commerce and Labor

Brief*

HB 2157 would amend the Employment Security Law to disqualify from benefits an individual who, initially hired by an adult care home or a home health agency, and then was subsequently convicted of a disqualifying felony and discharged under the statutes of either the adult care home or the home health agency.

Background
