SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2243

<u>As Recommended by House Committee on</u>
<u>Governmental Organization and Elections</u>

Brief*

HB 2243 would amend a law creating a joint water district involving the City of Lansing and Delaware Township, the Lan-Del Water District, in Leavenworth County. The bill would provide that assets and liabilities and territory of other water districts or joint water districts acquired by the city either through annexation or negotiation, may be transferred to the Lan-Del Water District.

Background

The bill was supported by Representative Kenny Wilk and a representative of the Lan-Del Water District. Proponents said the bill was needed to clarify the Lan-Del Water District can provide service within the boundaries of the city of Lansing in the event the city expands beyond the boundaries of Delaware Township.

The bill has no fiscal impact.
