SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2330

As Amended by House Committee on Health and Human Services

Brief*

HB 2330 would amend the Radiologic Technologists Practice Act, enacted in 2004, to delay the licensure requirements of the Act from July 1 to October 1, 2005. The bill also would make conforming amendments in statutory dates for other activities related to licensure of Radiologic Technologists. Finally, the bill would establish a number of certification requirements and titles for licensed radiologic technologists who have specialized training.

Background

The bill was introduced by the House Committee on Health and Human Services at the request of the Kansas Society of Radiologic Technologists. A representative of the Society and a representative of the State Board of Healing Arts presented testimony in support of the bill at the House Committee hearing. No opponents to the bill presented testimony at the House Committee hearing.

The representative of the Society suggested a technical amendment. The House Committee adopted the suggested amendment.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget on the introduced version of the bill states that the Board of Healing Arts does not anticipate that enactment would have any fiscal impact on the agency. The House Committee amendment would not materially change that assessment of potential fiscal impact.
