SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2469

<u>As Recommended by House Committee on</u>
<u>Governmental Organization and Elections</u>

Brief*

HB 2469 would allow the hospital board of Plainville Rural Hospital District No. 1 in Rooks County to mortgage hospital property for the purpose of financing the construction of a new hospital facility. The bill would require the mortgage be insured by a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) mortgage insurance program that specifically authorizes mortgage insurance for hospitals.

Background

Proponents of the bill included representatives of the Plainville Rural Hospital District No. 1 and the Kansas Hospital Association.

Passage of the bill would have no fiscal effect on the state budget, according to the fiscal note.
