SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 220

As Amended by Senate Committee of the Whole

Brief*

SB 220 would amend the crime of domestic battery to limit the number of diversion agreements a person may enter into to only one during a person's lifetime.

Background

The bill was supported by the Kansas Coalition Against Sexual and Domestic Violence. A representative of the Kansas County and District Attorney's Association objected to the bill as introduced, which would have permitted only one diversion in a person's lifetime for the crime of domestic battery.

The Senate Committee amended the bill to provide a person could enter into no more than two diversions every three years.

The Senate Committee of the Whole returned the bill to its original form, one diversion per a person's lifetime.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on the state.
