SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 278

As Recommended by House Committee on Transportation

Brief*

House Sub. for SB 278 would remove language from existing law that prohibits a person from operating a motorcycle with handlebars so positioned that the hands of the operator, when on the grips, are at or above should height when the person is sitting astride the seat with the vehicle in an upright position.

Background

Two persons representing ABATE of Kansas appeared before the House Transportation Committee in support of the bill. The content of House Sub. for SB 278 was originally contained in HB 2296.

The fiscal note prepared on HB 2296 indicates that the bill would not have a fiscal effect of any state budget.
