SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 440

As Recommended by Senate Committee on
Education

Brief*

SB 440 would clarify that Kansas residents who graduate from an accredited high school in another state would be eligible for admission at the state universities under the same admission standards as a Kansas resident who graduates from a Kansas high school. Under current law, Kansas residents who graduate from a high school in another state are not entitled to admission to a state university under the "qualified admissions" policy.

Background

Proponents of SB 440 testifying at the Senate Committee on Education hearing included Senator David Wysong and a representative of the Board of Regents. There were no opponents testifying to the Committee.

The fiscal note by the Division of the Budget stated that the bill would have no fiscal impact.
