SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 480

As Amended by House Committee of the Whole

Brief*

SB 480 would authorize expenditures from the State General Fund and various special revenue funds for the payment of specific claims against the State of Kansas. Agencies affected by the bill would include: the Department of Revenue; Norton Correctional Facility; Topeka Correctional Facility; Lansing Correctional Facility; Winfield Correctional Facility; Ellsworth Correctional Facility; Larned Correctional Facility; Hutchinson Correctional Facility; Larned Correctional Mental Health Facility; the State Fair; Wichita State University; Rainbow Mental Health Facility; the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services; and the Department of Agriculture.

Background

The House Committee of the Whole amended the bill to clarify to whom payment should be made in Section 7(e) and to reduce the amount of five personal injury claims against the Department of Corrections from \$1,000 to \$100.

The House Appropriations Committee amended the bill to include payment for damages incurred when unleaded gasoline was mistakenly returned to a underground diesel tank following an inspection. Other amendments were technical in nature.

The Senate Committee on Ways and Means amended the bill to add a claim for payment of an expired warrant. Other Senate Committee amendments were technical in nature.

The bill, as amended by the House Committee of the Whole, authorizes total expenditures of \$269,167 which includes \$87,692 from operating accounts of the State General Fund, and \$181,475 from other sources.
