### SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 536

# As Amended by Senate Committee on Judiciary

### **Brief\***

SB 536 would require an executor or administrator of an estate before making the distribution of the estate and a conservator in the final accounting of a conservatorship to confirm that medicaid reimbursements have been determined and paid.

## **Background**

The bill was suggested by a Wyandotte Country district judge.

The Senate Committee deleted an amendment to the medicaid fraud criminal statute and made a clarifying amendment.

The bill would increase medicaid estate recovery income but the amount cannot be estimated.
