SESSION OF 2006

SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2580

As Amended by House Committee on Governmental Organization and Elections

Brief*

HB 2580 would amend a law dealing with incorporated improvement districts to permit the board of directors to fix the amount of compensation for directors by passage of a resolution. If the compensation for each director would be more than \$100 annually, the resolution must be published twice in a newspaper of general circulation in the district.

Background

The bill was supported by a representative of the Oaklawn Improvement District in Sedgwick County. He said the bill is patterned after a law enacted several years ago in regard to compensation of township officials.

The House Committee made a clarifying amendment.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on the state and would have a minimal fiscal impact on improvement districts.
