SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 2609

As Amended by Senate Committee on Judiciary

Brief*

HB 2609 would amend the Small Claims Procedure Act to delete the requirement that the Office of Judicial Administration develop a form used to submit information related to small claims.

The bill is placed on the consent calendar.

Background

An official from the Kansas Judicial Council spoke in favor of the bill. He indicated that the stricken language conflicted with another section of the Small Claims Procedure Act in KSA 2005 Supp. 61-2713. The forms have been posted on the Judicial Council website at www.kscourts.org/council since June, 2005.

These forms also will be included in a new Judicial Council publication, *Kansas Legal Forms* in the near future.

The Senate Committee made a technical amendment.

The fiscal note indicated no fiscal effect.
