SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2631

As Recommended by House Committee on Transportation

Brief*

HB 2631 would allow a Kansas resident who submits proof to the Director of Vehicles that the person is a firefighter to be issued one distinctive motorcycle license plate.

Background

The Director of Vehicles presented the Committee with examples of the current firefighter plates used on passenger vehicles and trucks. The other conferee, Patrick T. Lehman, Kansas Fire Service Alliance, appeared in support of the bill. He told the Committee that during the 2004 Session, the Legislature approved the firefighter distinctive license plates for passenger vehicles and trucks. He said this bill merely expands firefighter license plates to include motorcycles.

The Department of Revenue estimates that the bill would have negligible fiscal effect from manufacturing, shipping, testing, and information systems costs. The Department states that it could absorb any additional costs associated with the passage of the bill.
