SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2831

As Recommended by House Committee on Health and Human Services

Brief*

HB 2831 would amend a statute in the Pharmacy Act that authorizes pharmacists to administer vaccines. The amendment would replace the American Council on Pharmaceutical Education with the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy as the entity designated to approve the training necessary for pharmacists to administer vaccines.

Background

The amendment was necessitated by the national organization changing its name.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget states that enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
