SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2983

As Amended by House Committee on Taxation

Brief*

HB 2983 would authorize additional local sales tax authority for Johnson County of either 0.1 percent; 0.2 percent; 0.25 percent; 0.3 percent; 0.4 percent; or 0.5 percent to finance public infrastructure projects, buildings (including equipment and furnishings), and the acquisition and improvement of real property.

Any such tax imposed would first have to be approved by voters.

Background

Proponents, who included the county commission and county sheriff, said that jail expansion and crime lab expansion were the highest priority projects relative to the earmarking of any new sales tax revenues.

The House Committee made technical amendments to the bill at the suggestion of the revisor.
