1 AN ACT concerning the Kansas state high school activities association;
2 authorizing certain students to participate in activities offered by school
3 districts; allowing nonpublic school students who enroll part time in a
4 public school to participate in nonpublic school activities.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. (a) Any student who meets the requirements of this section
8 shall be permitted to participate in any activities offered by a school
9 district that are regulated, supervised, promoted and developed by the
10 activities association referred to in K.S.A. 72-7114, and amendments
11 thereto. A student shall be permitted to participate in any such activities if
12 such student:

13 (1) Is a resident of the school district;
14 (2) is enrolled and attending a nonpublic elementary or secondary
15 school;

16 (3) complies with the requirements of K.S.A. 72-6262, and
17 amendments thereto, prior to participation in any such activity;

18 (4) meets any applicable age and eligibility requirements set forth by
19 the activities association referred to in K.S.A. 72-7114, and amendments
20 thereto, that are not otherwise in conflict with this section; ~~and~~

21 (5) pays any fees required by the school district for participation in
22 such activity if such fees are generally imposed upon all other students
23 who participate in such activity.

24 (b) ~~The board of education of a school district may require a student~~
25 who participates in an activity pursuant to this section to enroll in a
26 particular course or complete a particular course as a condition of
27 participation, if such requirement is imposed upon all other students who
28 participate in such activity.

29 Sec. 2. The activities association referred to in K.S.A. 72-7114, and
30 amendments thereto, shall not prohibit a student primarily enrolled in and
31 attending a nonpublic school who enrolls part time in a public school from
32 participating in any activity available to such student as part of such
33 student's primary enrollment and attendance at a nonpublic school.

34 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
35 publication in the statute book.

(6) seeks participation at the appropriate school of the school district that corresponds to where such student resides within the school district's respective school attendance boundaries established by the board of education of the school district.

(d) Except as provided in subsection (b), any student who seeks to participate in an activity pursuant to this section shall be subject to any tryout or other participation requirements that are otherwise applicable to all other students for participation in the activity.

Attachment 1

(1) Any student attending a home school who seeks to participate in an activity in the student's resident school district shall be deemed to meet any academic eligibility requirements set by the activities association for participation in an activity if:

(A) The student is mastering the material in each course or subject being taught to such student;

(B) the student is maintaining satisfactory progress towards achievement or promotion to the next grade level; and

(C) the parent, teacher or organization that provides instruction to the student submits an affidavit to the activities association indicating the student meets the academic eligibility requirements of subparagraphs (A) and (B).

(2) Upon submission of an affidavit, the student attending a home school shall be considered to meet any academic eligibility requirements established by the activities association and shall retain such academic eligibility for any activities during the activity season for which such affidavit is submitted.
