Our History

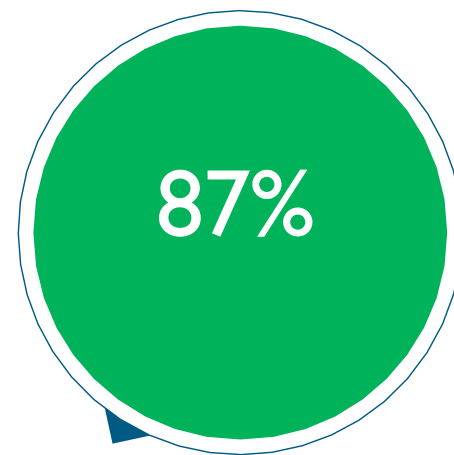
- Pressley Ridge was founded in 1832 in Pittsburgh, PA as two Protestant orphanages.

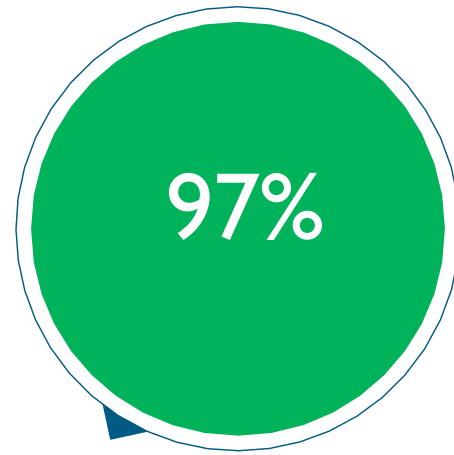

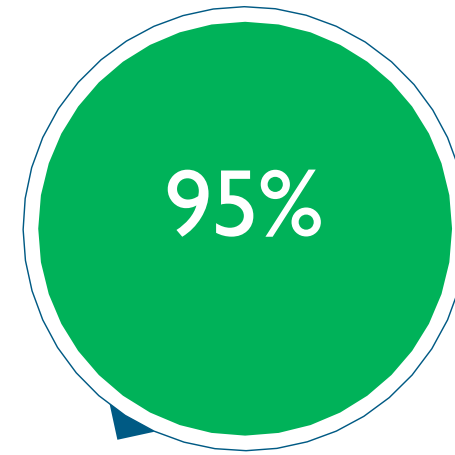

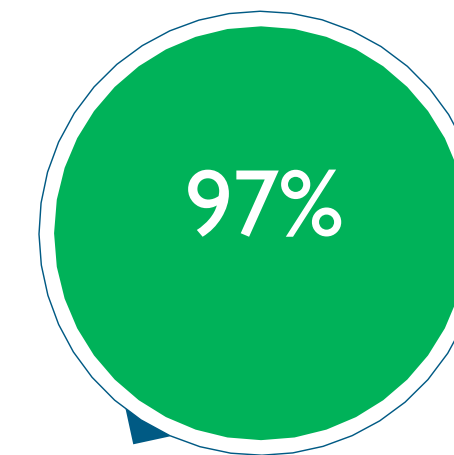

Pre-Service Training Curriculum

Pressley Ridge's curriculum is the only evidence-based pre-service training program developed specifically for treatment parents

In May 2020, the California Evidence –Based Clearinghouse for Child Welfare rated the curriculum in the areas of:

Used by over 200 organizations

Located in 36 states plus Canada, the District of Columbia

Mandated state-wide in Colorado

Listed as an approved training practice in North Carolina, Alaska & California

What We Bring to Kansas PR-TFC Pre-Service Training

- **April 2024 – Awarded contract to increase Treatment Foster Family Homes in Kansas**
- **May 2024 – Began collaborative Engagement with Child Placing Agencies (CPAs)**
- **June 2024 – First PR-TFC training made available in the Lawrence, KS**
- **July 2024 – Second PR-TFC training made available in Olathe, KS**
- **Sept. 2024 – Third PR-TFC training made available in Wichita, KS.**
- **September 2024 – Became a state approved pre-service training**



What We Bring to Kansas Child Welfare Professionals Kinship Support Training:

- In addition to the PR-TFC Pre-Service Training Curriculum, Pressley Ridge has a vast amount of experience supporting kinship families.
- Building competencies of child welfare professionals on how they can best support/coach Kinship Caregivers through clinical lens.
- Steering Committee and Sub Committees of Lived Experience Individuals
- The training is expected to be available in the summer of 2025
