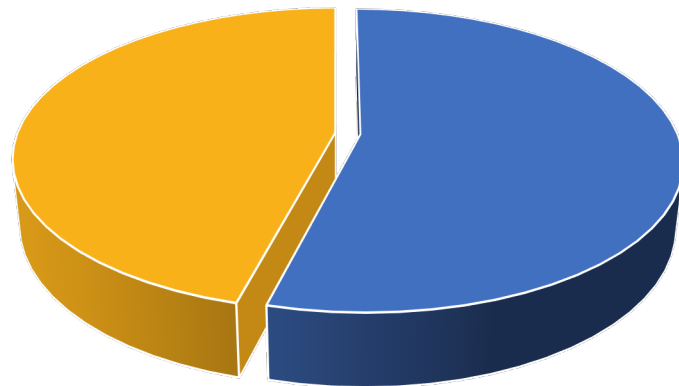

# BIL Overview

- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)
  - AKA Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)
- National Infrastructure Investment = \$1.2 Trillion across 5 years
  - Nearly 400 programs across 12 Federal Agencies
  - 60% Formula / 40% Discretionary

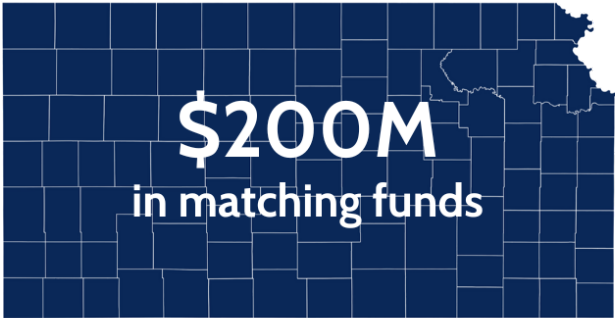

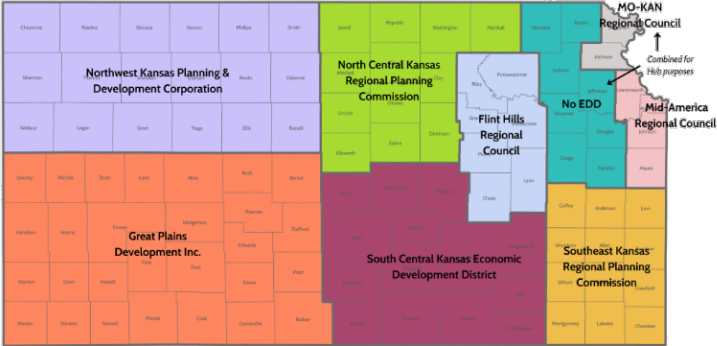
# Build Kansas Fund – Match Support



The Build Kansas Fund provides matching funds...

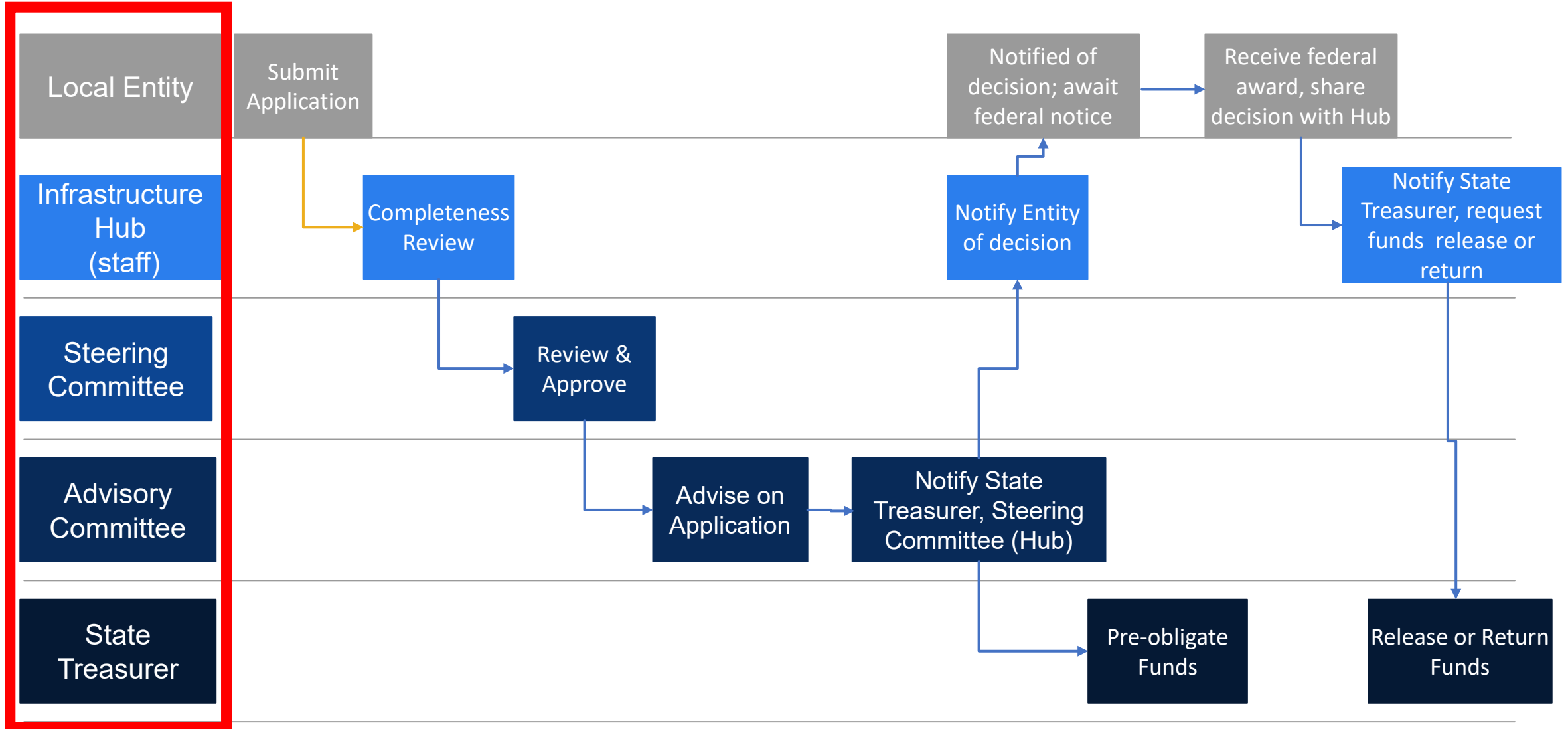
4-Year Lifespan

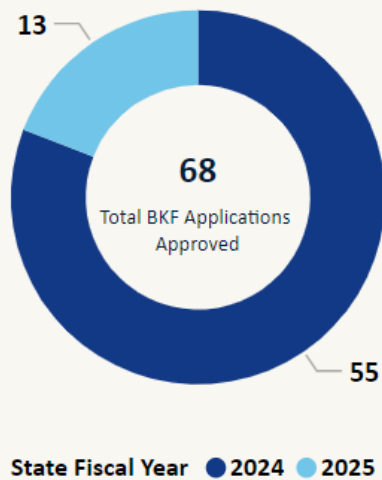

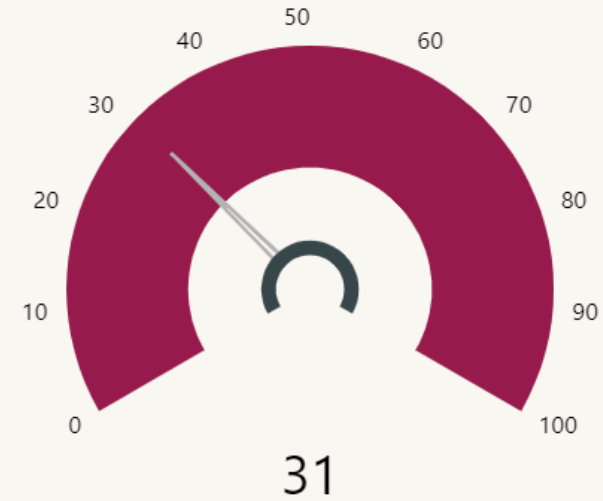
### Build Kansas Funds Remaining (for Commitment)



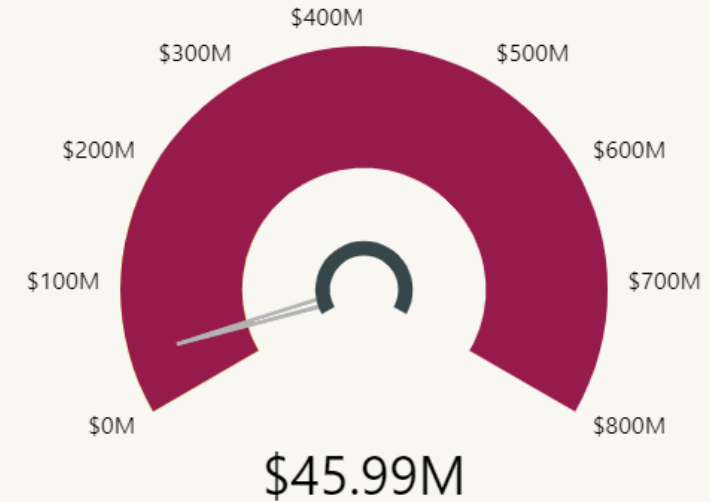
### Build Kansas Fund Applications Approved



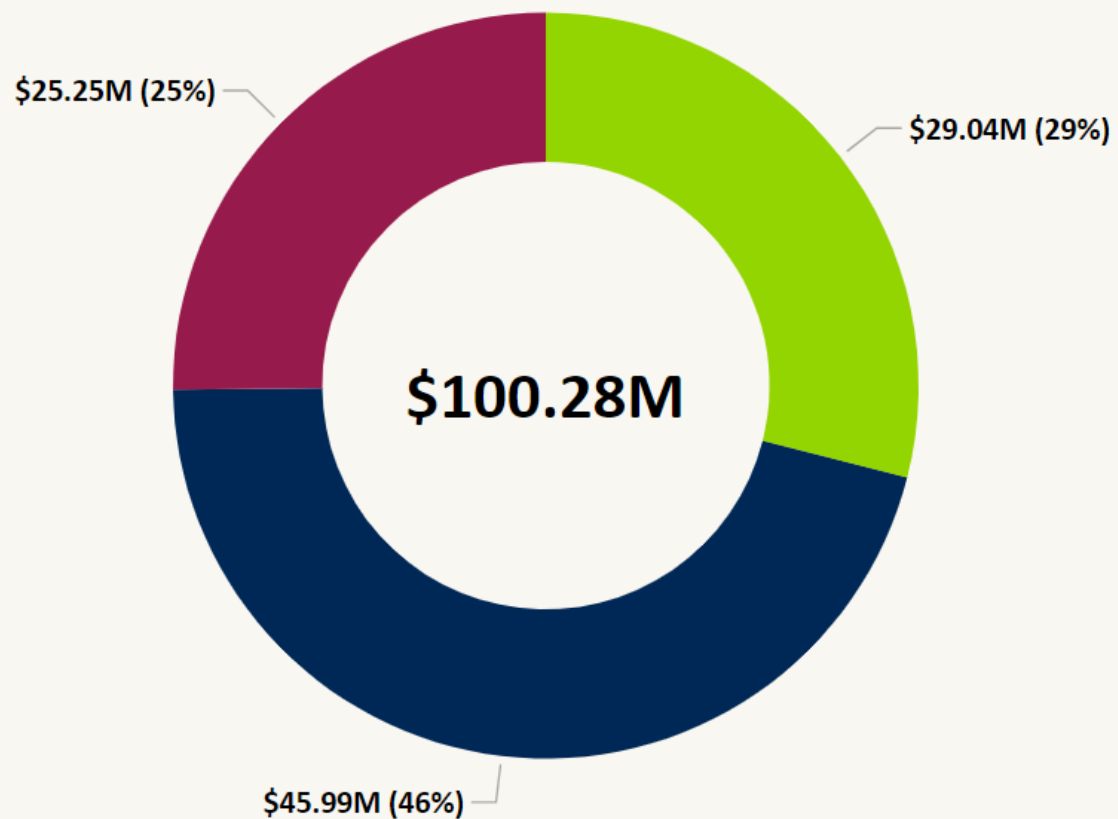
### Count of Federal Awards

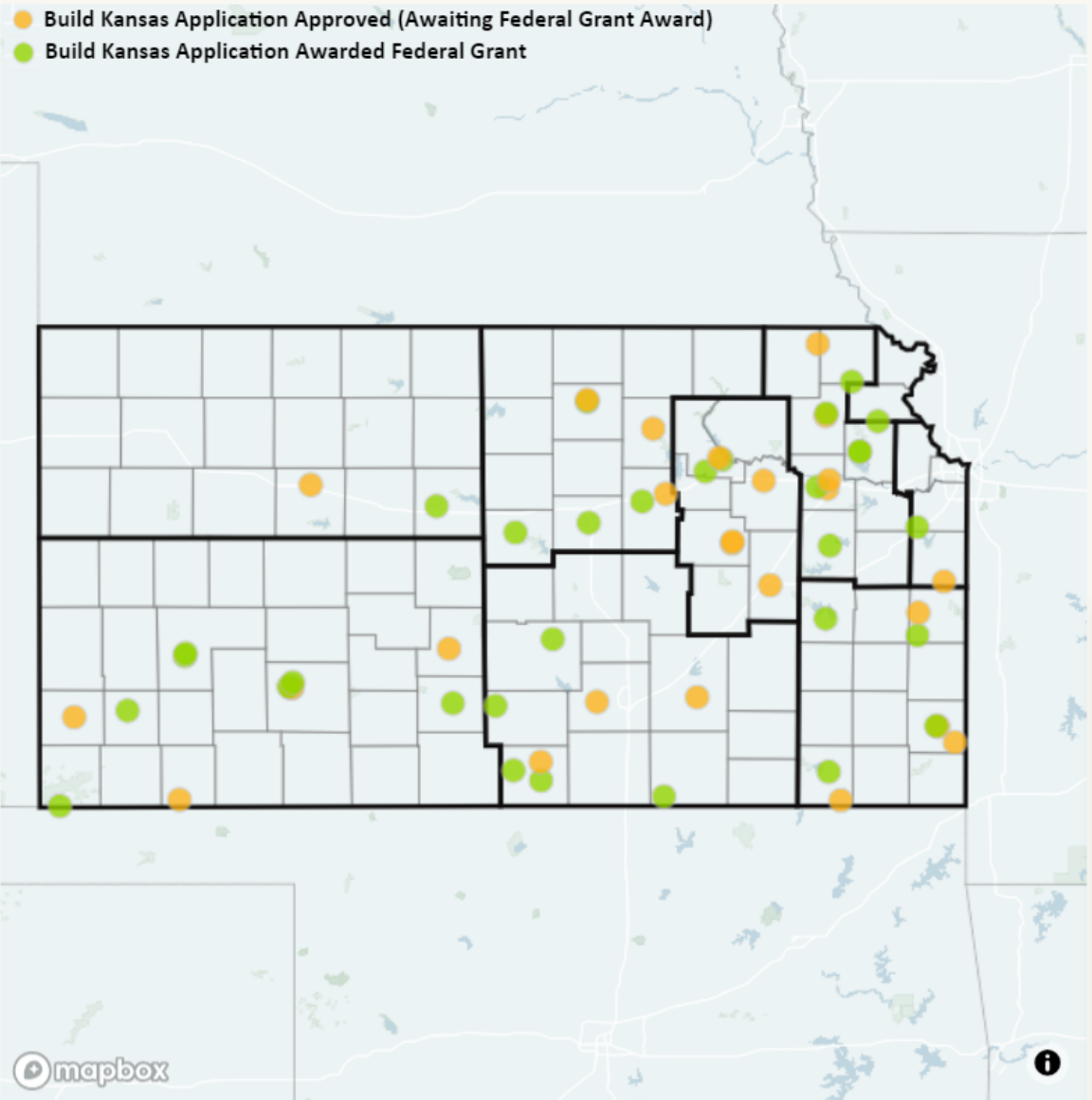

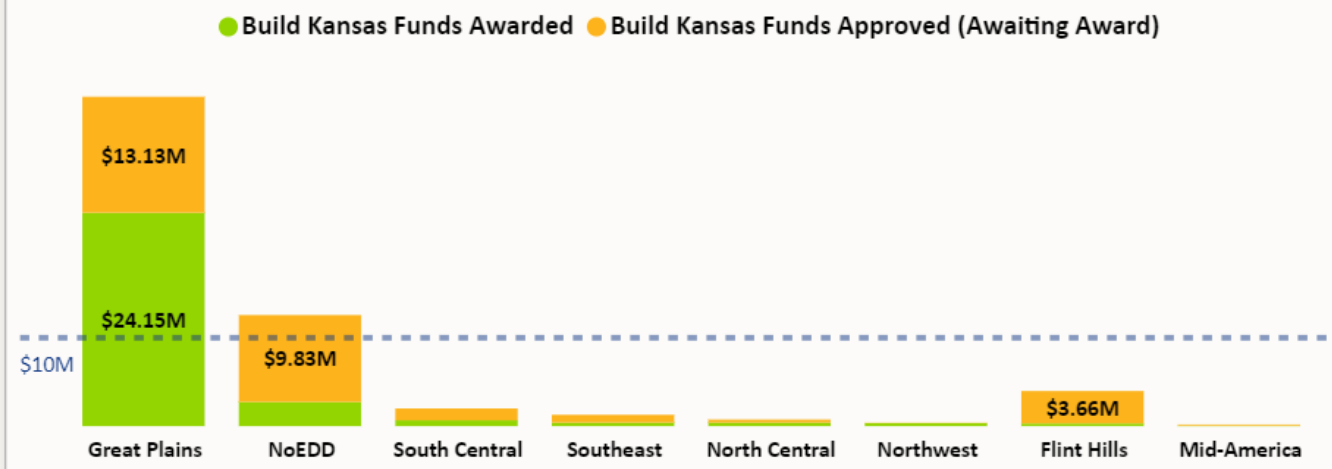

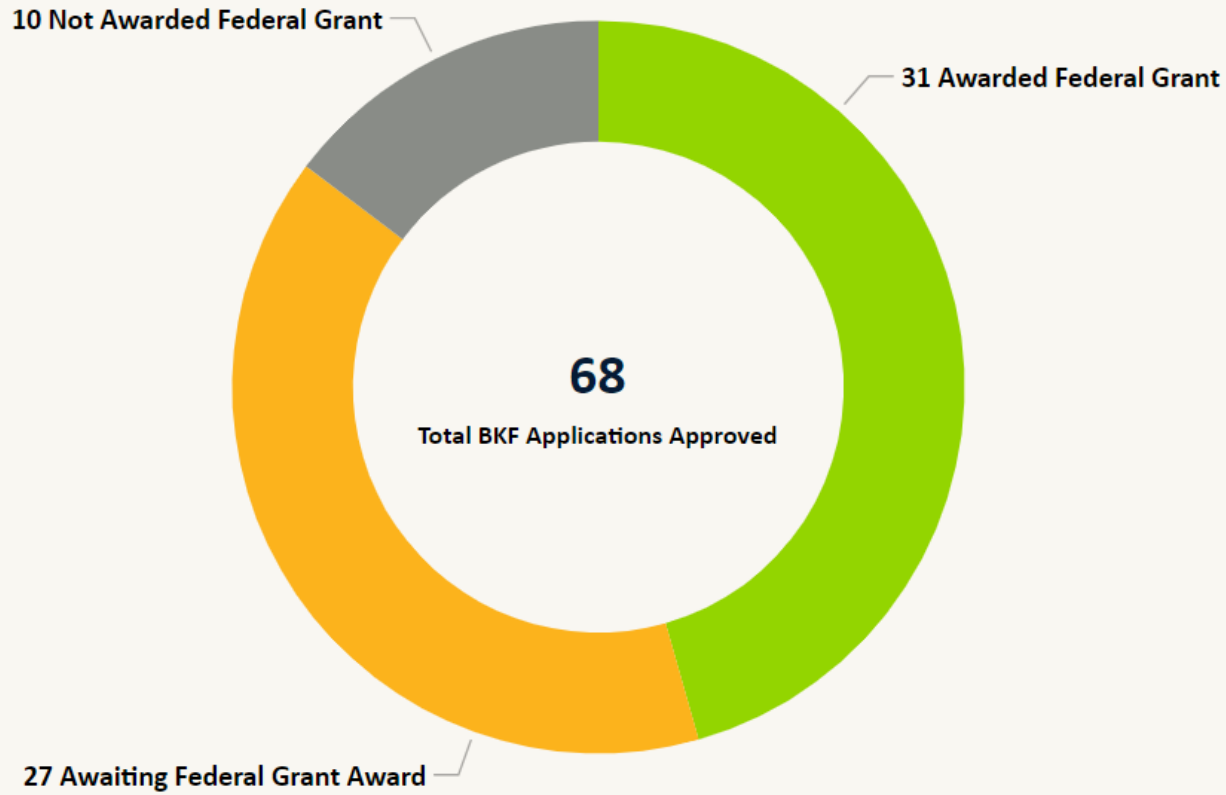

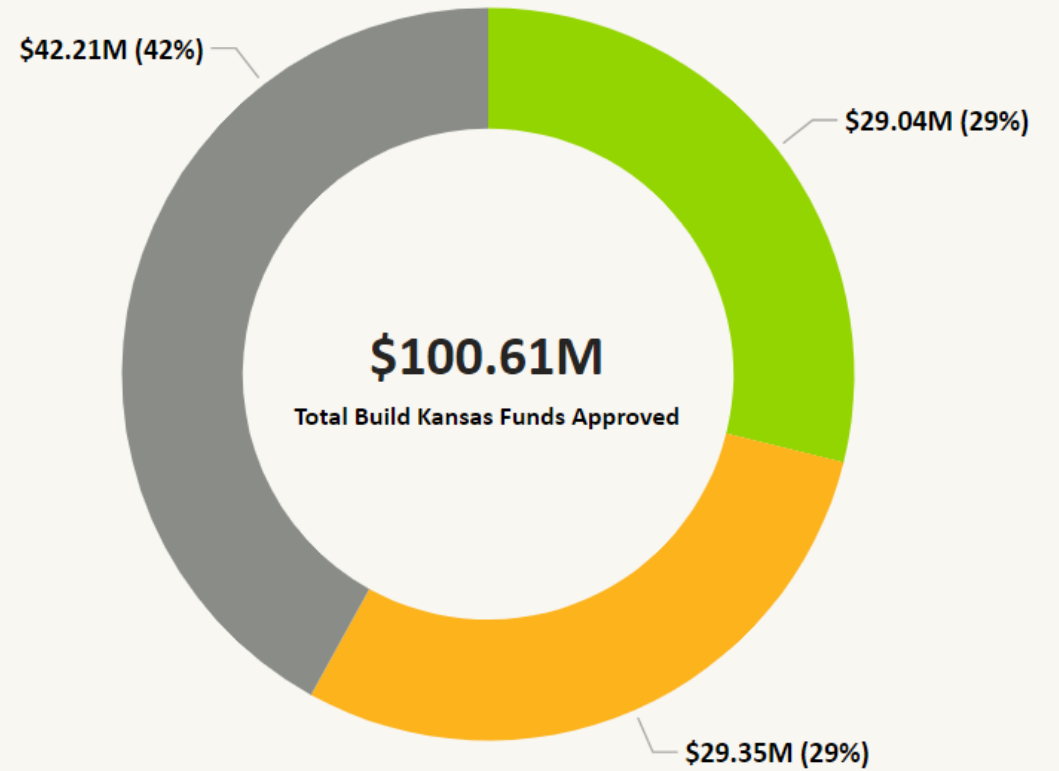


### Status of Build Kansas Fund Applications

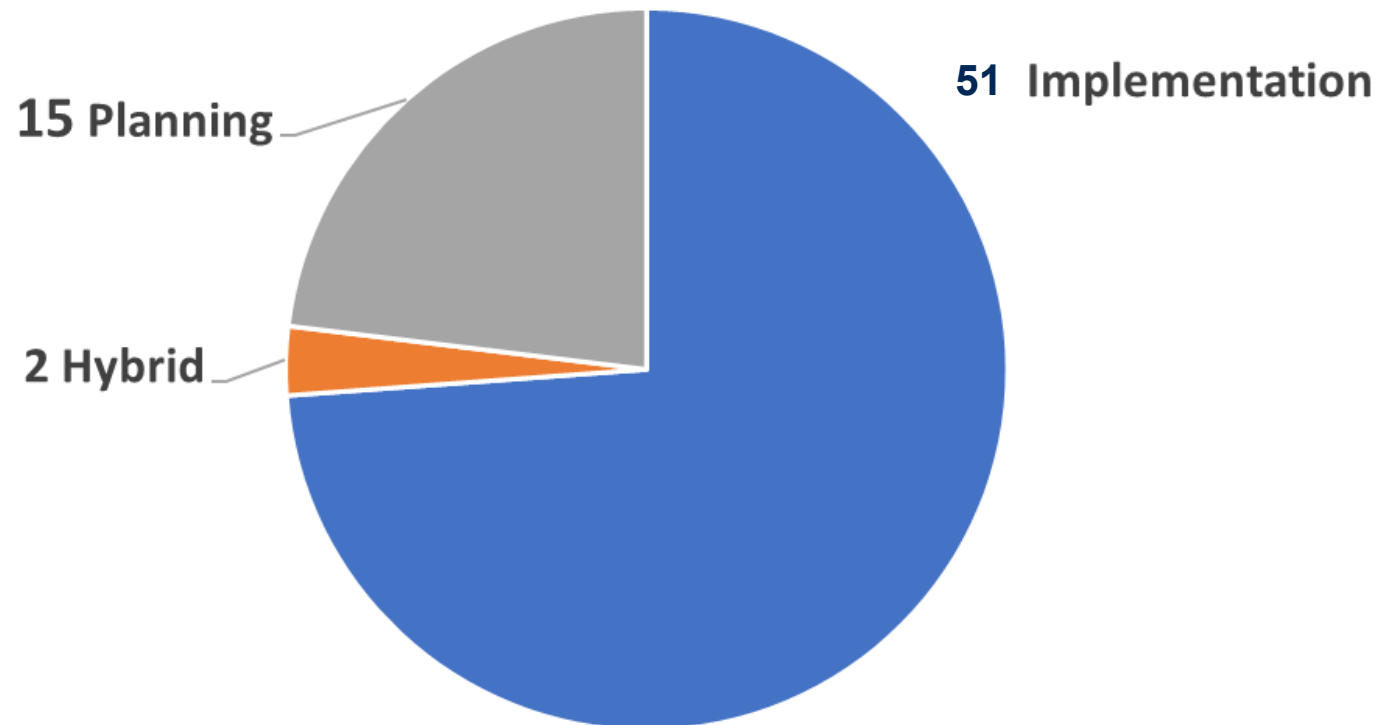

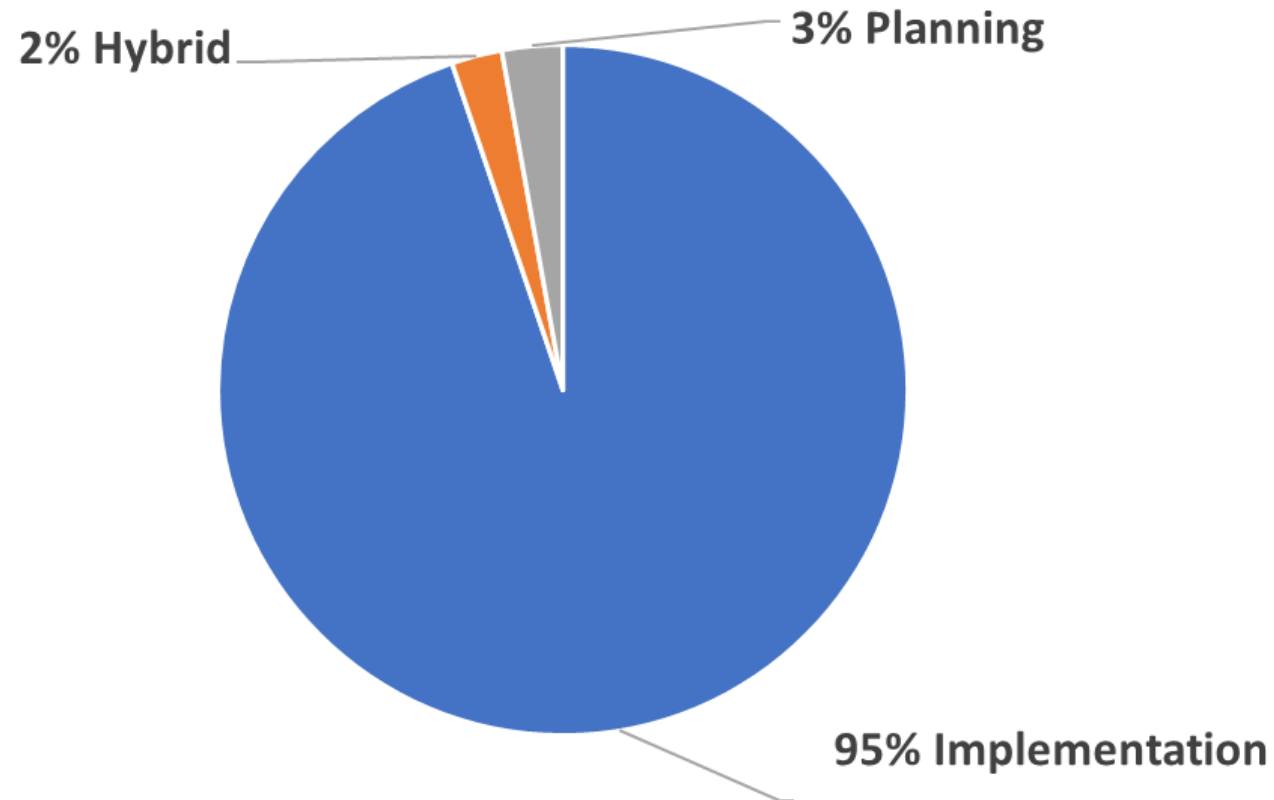
# Funding of Implementation and Planning Projects by BKF

Build Kansas Fund – Project Type by BKF Project Funding %



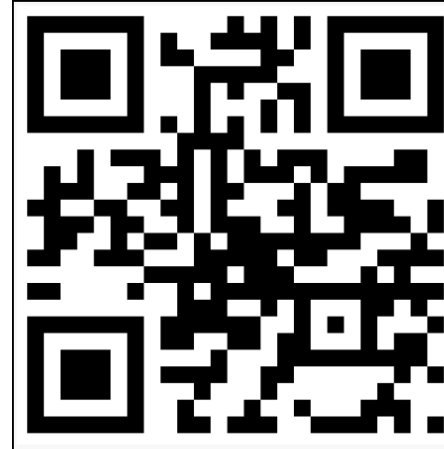
