Proposed Amendments for SB 71 Senate Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources February 21, 2023 Office of Revisor of Statutes

AN ACT concerning agriculture; relating to the Kansas department of authorizing agriculture; requiring the secretary of agriculture to establish a division 2 nonprofit organization and of sustainable agriculture that shall apply for federal grant funds [under-3 the greenhouse gas reduction fund to assist farmers in converting to 4 5 renewable energy and sustainable agriculture practices. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. (a) As used in this section: 8 (1) "Renewable natural gas plant" means a facility that converts 9 or byproducts agricultural commodities to methane. 10 (2) "Sustainable agriculture district" means an improvement district incorporated pursuant to K.S.A. 19-2753 et seg., and amendments thereto, 12 to provide means whereby producers of agricultural commodities can reap 13 economic benefits from renewable energy and sustainable agriculture 14 while limiting consumptive water use 15 practices! (3) "Sustainable ammonia or urea plant" means a facility that 16 produces ammonia or urea, has a capacity of less than 50,000 tons per year 17 18 and either: 19 (A) Does not consume methane as feedstock; or (B) (i) consumes predominantly biomethane as feedstock; or 20 The secretary of agriculture shall create a nonprofit organization called (ii) sequesters at least 60% of the carbon dioxide produced by the "Kansas sustainable agriculture fund". Such nonprofit organization 22 methane consumption. shall be qualified to obtain funds through federal grants. (b) (1) On or before June 1, 2023, the Kansas department of 23 (c) The secretary 24 agriculture shall establish a division of sustainable agriculture. (2) Such division of sustainable agriculture shall have the express 25 ability to allocate federal purpose of dispersing grants, loans, bond guarantees and other financial and technical assistance to sustainable agriculture districts using funds from the Kansas sustainable agriculture fund obtained by grants from the federal greenhouse gas reduction fund 28 established by 42 U.S.C. § 7434 for the construction and commissioning 29 of renewable natural gas plants or sustainable ammonia or urea plants, or a 30 combination of both. 31 (c) (1) The secretary of agriculture shall further create a nonprofit 32 33 organization called "the Kansas sustainable agriculture fund" that qualifiesas an eligible recipient within the meaning of 42 U.S.C. § 7434. 34 (2) Such nonprofit organization shall be designed to obtain funds-35

[(3) Such funds shall be used to provide capital, leverage private capital and provide other forms of financial assistance to sustainable agriculture districts for the construction and commissioning of renewable natural gas plants or sustainable ammonia or urea plants, or a combination of both.]

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.

(d) This section shall apply to any facility commissioned after January 1, 2023.
