

School Sanitary Inspections—County Home Rule; HB 2754

HB 2754 allows a county to exempt itself from law requiring the local health officer to conduct an annual sanitary inspection of each school building and its grounds. Such exemption would be made pursuant to home rule powers granted to counties under county home rule law. [Note: Other duties of the local health officer specified in KSA 65-202 could not be exempted by a county under continuing law.]
