Reconciliation Bill; SB 27

SB 27 reconciles amendments to statutes that were amended more than once during the current and prior legislative sessions. For such statutes, the bill repeals one version and, if necessary, amends the continuing version with noncontradictory amendments, creating a single version of the statute containing all amendments.

[Note: The Office of Revisor of Statutes submits a bill of this type each legislative session to reconcile and consolidate conflicting versions of the statutes.]
