

Amendments to the Kansas Fights Addiction Act; SB 307

SB 307 amends the Kansas Fights Addiction Act to include for-profit private entities in the definition of “qualified applicant” and authorize members of the Kansas Fights Addiction Grant Review Board (Board) to receive certain compensation for attending meetings.

Qualified Applicants

The bill adds for-profit private entities to the definition of “qualified applicants” that may apply for grants from the Kansas Fight Addiction Fund for projects and activities that prevent, reduce, treat, or mitigate the effect of substance abuse and addiction. Grant applications from these entities are subject to approval by the Board.

Board Member Compensation

The bill authorizes members of the Board to be paid subsistence allowances, mileage, and other expenses when attending meetings of the Board after January 8, 2024.
