The House met session pro forma pursuant to adjournment with Speaker Hawkins in the chair.

## INTRODUCTION OF BILLS AND CONCURRENT RESOLUTIONS

The following bills were introduced and read by title:

**HB 2468**, AN ACT concerning education; relating to federal tax credits for contributions to scholarship granting organizations; electing to participate in the federal tax credit for individual contributions to scholarship granting organizations; relating to the tax credit for low income students scholarship program; increasing the aggregate tax credit limit; amending K.S.A. 2025 Supp. 72-4357 and repealing the existing section, by Committee on Education.

**HB 2469**, AN ACT concerning taxation; relating to credits; expanding the income tax credit for qualified railroad track maintenance expenditures to include credits against certain premium taxes, privilege fees and privilege taxes; allowing the transfer of unused credits to any individual or entity subject to such taxes; amending K.S.A. 2025 Supp. 79-32,297 and repealing the existing section, by Committee on Taxation.

**HB 2470**, AN ACT concerning economic development; relating to the Kansas neighborhood revitalization act; providing that certain municipalities may designate the entire municipality within a neighborhood revitalization area; amending K.S.A. 12-17,116 and repealing the existing section, by Committee on Taxation.
