Subject:	HB 2102 – Providing for the advance enrollment of military students
	whose parent or person acting as parent will be stationed in this state.

House Bill No. 2102 (HB 2102) would amend K.S.A. 72-3128, which establishes the requirements for nonresident students wanting to enroll in a school district that has open seats for enrollment under the open enrollment provisions. The bill would provide that military students who provide evidence that their parent or person acting as parent will be stationed in Kansas either during the current school year or in the next school year can enroll in the school district prior to physically moving to the state. Such enrollment would grant the student the same opportunities as other students enrolled in the school district, such as course selection, and preparation for implementation of any IEP or 504 plan the student may have.

If enacted, HB 2102 would become effective on July 1, 2025.
