Subject: HB 2146—Summary

Under current law, of the revenue from lottery tickets sold from vending machines, the first \$10.0 million in net profits in FY 2025 and \$8.0 million in FY 2026 is required to be transferred to fund mental health programs at the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services 75% to Community Crisis Stabilization Centers Fund and 2 to the Clubhouse Model Program Fund.

HB 2146 would increase the cap to the first \$16.0 million in net profits from vending machines beginning in FY 2026.
