Subject: **HB 2120,** authorizing the state board of regents to sell and convey certain real property in Riley county, Kansas, and Douglas county, Nebraska, on behalf of Kansas state university and Kansas state university veterinary medical center.

HB2120 would authorize the state board of regents to sell and convey on certain real property in Riley county, Kansas, and Douglas county, Nebraska, on behalf of Kansas state university and Kansas state university veterinary medical center. The bills require the deeds, titles and conveyances to be reviewed and approved by the attorney general. The sales would be exempt from K.S.A. 75-3043a, requirement of appraisal, and K.S.A. 75-6609, state surplus property requirements. The proceeds from the sales would be deposited in the restricted fees funds of Kansas state university and Kansas state university veterinary medical center.

The bill becomes effective upon the publication in the Kansas register.
