8 9	Section 1. K.S.A. 28-110 is hereby amended to read as follows: 28- 110. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section :	
10	(1) On and after July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013, the sheriff of	
10	each Kansas county shall charge a fee of \$10 for serving, executing and	
12	returning any process.	
12	(2) On and after July 1, 2013, the sheriff of each Kansas county shall	
14	charge a fee of \$15 for serving, executing and returning any process,	
15	except that no fee shall be charged for serving, executing and returning	
16	any process for a proceeding pursuant to the protection from abuse act as	
17	described in K.S.A. 60-3104, and amendments thereto, or the protection	
18	from stalking, sexual assault and human trafficking act as described in	
19	K.S.A. 60-31a04, and amendments thereto?	, or a similar proceeding based on the laws of another jurisdiction
20	(b) Subject to subsection (e), the fee described in subsection (a) shall	
21	be charged for serving, executing and returning process, as well as for any	
22	unsuccessful attempts to serve, execute or return process.	
23	(c) If more than one process for the same person in the same case is	
24	issued and is in the hands of a sheriff at one time, the sheriff shall charge a	
25	single fee for serving, executing and returning the processes.	
26	(d) If more than one process for different persons at the same address	
27	in the same case is issued and is in the hands of a sheriff at one time, the	
28	sheriff shall charge a single fee for serving, executing and returning the	
29	processes.

3 (f) Except as provided by K.S.A. 19-269, and amendments thereto, a 4 sheriff shall be reimbursed for the necessary transportation and board 5 expenses incurred while serving under requisition made by the governor.

6 (g) All fees charged by a sheriff pursuant to this section for the same 7 case may be paid in one combined payment, in a form designated by the 8 sheriff, such as a check or money order.

9 (h) The state of Kansas and all municipalities in this state, as defined 10 in K.S.A. 12-105a, and amendments thereto, are hereby exempt, in any 11 civil action in which such state or municipality is involved, from paying 12 service of process fees prescribed by this section.

(i) As used in this section, "process" means any summons, pleading,
writ, order or notice issued by a court clerk or court.
