For your reference, here is the data that I have received from the KLRD that I cited in my questions to the Attorney General.

There was a previous e-mail correspondence with additional data, but this one filters it down to the specific questions I asked KLRD morning.

As I interpret the data, over the past 18 years, 32 cases out of 546 appealed from a state Supreme Court have been affirmed (5.9%). The rest of the cases (94.1%) were either overruled or vacated and remanded down to a lower court for review.
