RE: House Bill 2208

Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee:

On behalf of the Topeka Community Foundation, I am writing in support of HB 2208 – establishing a tax credit for endowment gifts to certain endowment funds held by qualified community foundations.

The Topeka Community Foundation primarily serves Topeka and Shawnee County – but makes health related grants in an additional nine counties in Kansas.

As our foundation focuses on inclusive economic development and the social determinants of health, unrestricted grant dollars are one of the most powerful tools we can leverage. These funds allow us to respond quickly to emerging needs, invest strategically in long-term solutions, and support innovative programs that strengthen our communities.
